Tissue Stiffness of The Tongue In Obese OSA Minipigs,

March. 2021 - March 2023

University of Washington School of Dentistry, Seattle, WA

Obesity is a common finding and a major pathogenetic factor in adult obstructive sleep apnea (OSA). Increased visceral and/or upper airway adipose composition and metabolic abnormality have been found in obese/OSA patients. To understand the mechanisms of obesity in relation to OSA, this study was to investigate the tissue stiffness of the tongue in obese OSA minipig model.

The Influence of Global Warming on Coral Microbiomes,

January. 2019 - November. 2019

University of Washington, Bothell, WA

As a capstone independent research project, I conducted a computational analysis of the Global Coral Microbiome Project, a large 16s rRNA gene amplicon library dataset (1440 16s rRNA amplicon libraries). Our project tested whether reef temperature affects the microbiome of some corals more than others. We concluded that reef temperature may influence the microbiome composition of some coral species but because our data remains inconclusive, this is an assumption based on visual interpretation. The beta analysis for tissue does show us that there is some aspect of the coral's habitat that does have an influence on its microbiome, but the specificity of this is unclear without further research.

The Effects of Density on The Ratio of *Ceratopteris Richardii* Gametophytes,

The research investigates if spore density leads to a change in the ratio of male gametophytes. The research tests 6 different densities of spores in a petri dish to see if the density of spores affected the hermaphrodite to male C. richardii ratio. The hypothesis is that there should be a correlation between the density of spores and the ratio between the sexes.

The Effects of Common Substances on Oral Bacterial Growth,

January. 2018 - May. 2018

This collaborative research investigated what foods or drinks we consume could have varying effects on bacterial growth in our mouths. The most aggressive bacterial growth was selected to ensure the most expressive results. The hypothesis is that the different food we eat has varying effects on bacterial growth in our mouths and that alcoholic mouthwash kills more bacteria than non-alcoholic mouthwash. This study was presented to professional staff and students, and the research team answered questions about the research.

Phylogeny of Five Species Based on Protein Profile Using Gel Electrophoresis,

A research project that examined muscle protein components of five fish species, which are Coho Salmon, Rainbow Trout, Albacore Tuna, Skate, and Petrale Sole.
